The fee is nonrefundable after acceptance to the Bazaar. We reserve the right to select vendors based on balancing the Bazaar with an appropriate mix of Scandinavian and non-Scandinavian items and space available.

### Vendor Application

**Space is limited.** Spaces will be assigned by event coordinator. Set up in designated space only. Please bring your own holiday décor/display fixtures. Electricity will be provided, but you must provide your own electrical power strips and cords, in compliance with Washington State Fire and Safety Code. Your area will have a table but will **NOT** have a wall for affixing signs or items for sale. You are responsible to set up and maintain your display so that no threat or nuisance is made to the public. We encourage set-up on Friday, when the building will be open from 9 a.m. until 8 p.m. You may unload your sale items from the parking on the south side of the building.

**Please note that 10% of gross sales (less the application fee of \$50) will be due** at the end of the event to the Swedish Cultural Center in the form of a check, or, if paying with cash, rounded to the nearest dollar. The Center and anyone working on the sale will take every reasonable precaution to avoid loss, damage, or theft of those items for sale at the Scandinavian Holiday Bazaar. The building is locked except during the sale, however, we assume no responsibility in the event of loss, damage, or theft, or injury to anyone participating in the event. We ask that each vendor be responsible for dismantling or covering their display after hours and collecting money for sales.
