- ✓ Finalists must be available for a personal interview.

Note: Swedish ancestry not required.

Finalists will be selected on the following basis:

- a) The candidate's high school record.
- b) ACT or SAT score.
- c) Financial assessment.
- d) Leadership and community service.

Finalists will be selected by May 1, 2012. **Finalists must be available for a personal interview**, which will take place on Saturday, May 19, 2012. Awards will be granted for fall quarter/semester, 2012, and will be paid directly to the college/university.
